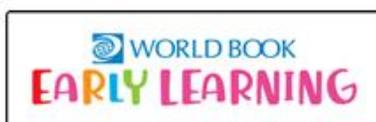

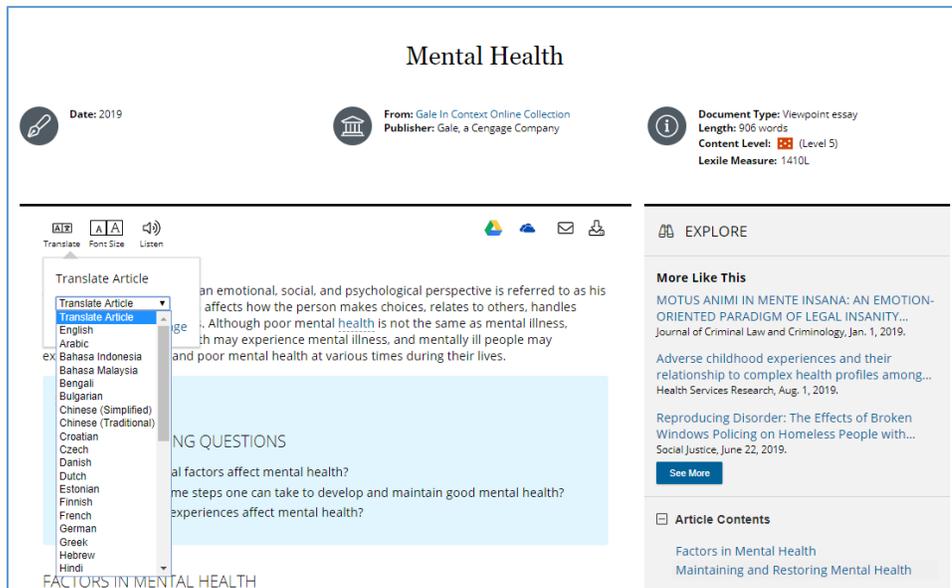
The Spanish version of the Kids encyclopedia has all the games, tools and features of the English version. It also includes Spanish-language newspapers.



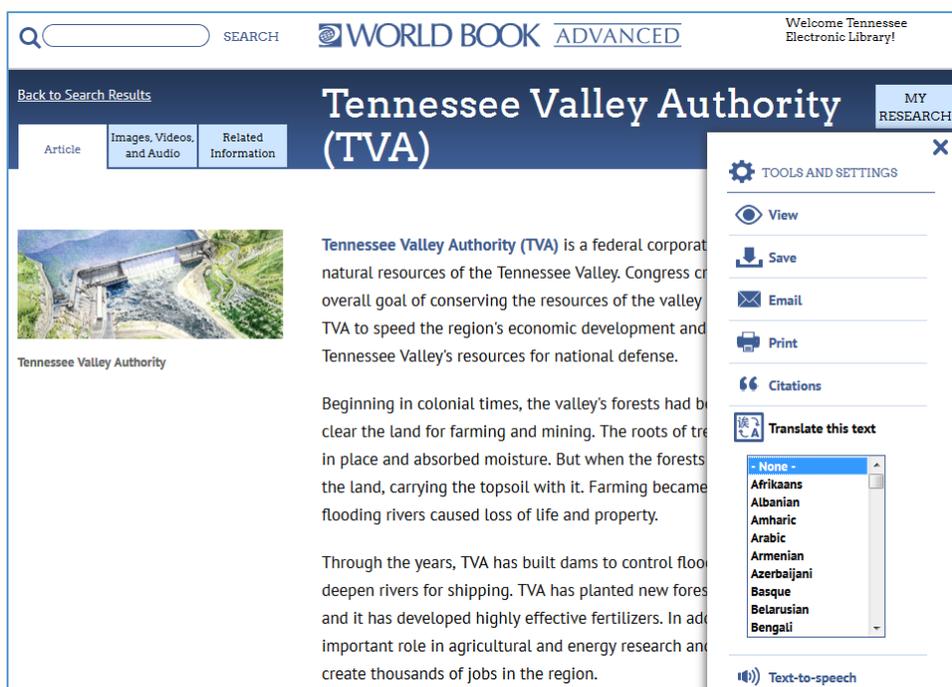
